It was noticed that if you CSV imported actor relations you couldn't subsequently search actors by relation type and see the corresponding actor as expected.

For example:

- 1) Alice and Puppy are actors
- 2) A relation of Alice controls Puppy is imported as CSV
- 3) Searching by the "controls" relationship type wouldn't bring up either

This should fix that.
