**Description**

In the report:

- Two separate dc.creator columns were added in the metadata.csv in Archivematica, one creator name per column
- The resulting METS file looks fine with separate <dc:creator> tags
- Other repeatable fields such as dc.coverage appear in AtoM without issue

The fact that it appeared properly in the METS file suggests that the issue lies in AtoM's DIP upload processing.
