Description

To reproduce

- Log in as an admin
- Navigate to Admin > Users and create a new translator user.
- Add French as an allowed language for translation.
- Log out, and log in as the new translator user
- Go to a random description flip the UI to a different language than French (e.g. Spanish), enter edit mode, and add a translation.

Resulting error

- User can add translations to all existing records in any language

Expected result

- Only French translations are allowed, edits/translations in other languages are not allowed and the translation permissions denied message is shown instead when attempting to enter edit mode
